To make your driving experience in the United States safe and enjoyable, Hertz is providing you with this "Rules of the Road" pamphlet. Please note, however, that this pamphlet **does not** represent a complete list of the motor vehicle and traffic laws of the various states. Regardless of whether or not a specific law is outlined below, **it is your responsibility** as the renter/driver to comply with all applicable motor vehicle and traffic laws.

DON'T DRINK AND DRIVE! - Each state strictly enforces prohibitions against Driving While Intoxicated and/or Driving While Impaired.

WEAR SEATBELTS - IT'S THE LAW! - Also, the use of child seats for infants and small children (usually under age 5) is required in all states. Place child seats in the rear seat only.

STAY TO THE RIGHT - In the United States, motor vehicles are operated on the right hand side of the road. Use extra caution to stay to the right at all times - especially if you are from a left-hand drive country.

OBEY THE SPEED LIMIT - In most states, the maximum highway speed is 65 miles per hour (104 kilometers per hour) in rural areas and 55 mph (88 kph) in urban areas. Speed limits on secondary roads and in cities and towns are usually significantly lower, generally 30 mph (48 kph) and even lower in school zones.

OBEY TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND HIGHWAY MARKINGS -

Traffic signals generally display one of three colors at any time. Green means go. Red means stop. Yellow means the light will be turning red momentarily, stop if you have sufficient time to do so safely. Blinking yellow means proceed with caution. Blinking red means STOP, and then proceed with caution when traffic is clear. Highway marking lines separating lanes of traffic moving in the same direction are white. Lines separating lanes of traffic moving in the opposite direction are yellow. You may pass another vehicle moving in the same direction when traffic is clear and you experience a single broken line or when your side of a double line is broken. U-turns across double yellow lines are prohibited.

STOP FOR SCHOOL BUSES - Traffic approaching in both directions must stop for a school bus with its red lights flashing.
