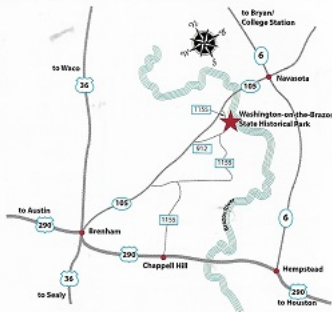

## Washington-on-the-Brazos State Historical Park

The 59 delegates learn of the plight of Colonel Travis and his 257 men fighting against 3000 Mexican soldiers. Sam Houston urges the delegates to stay and draft a constitution and establish a government for the emerging Republic.

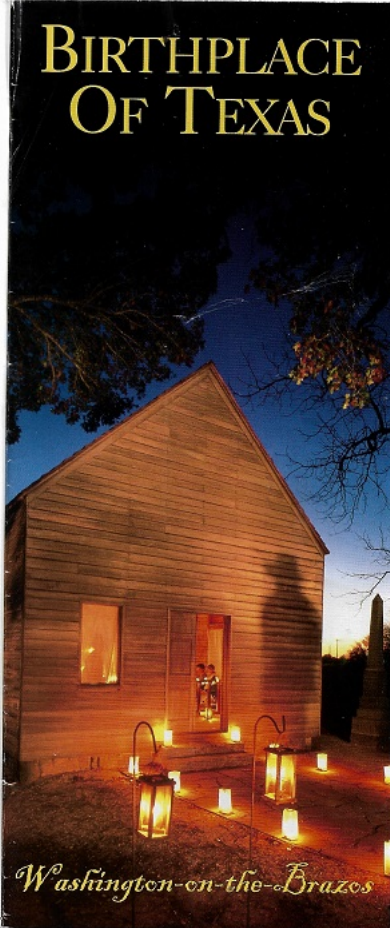

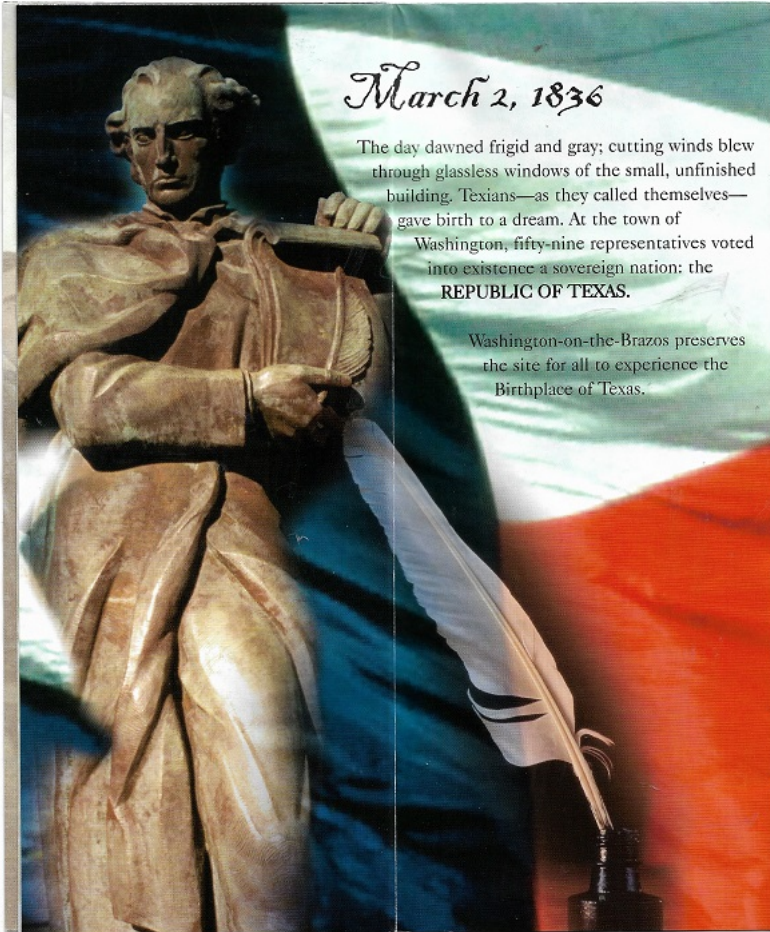

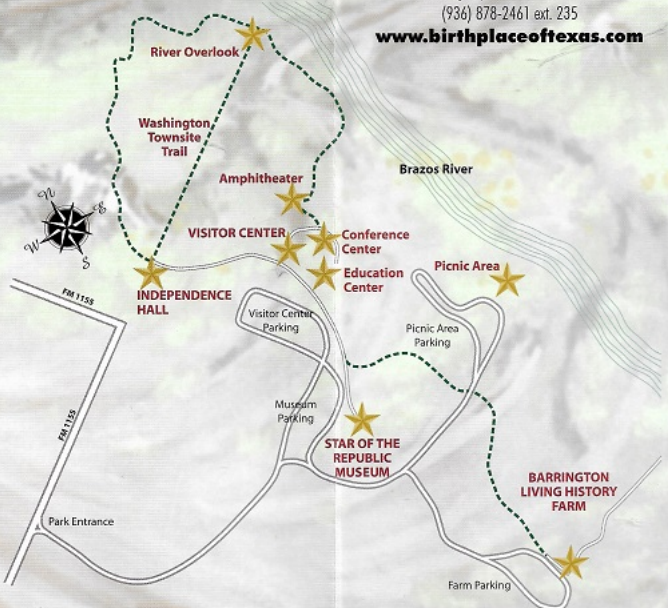


## *March 2, 1836*

The day dawned frigid and gray; cutting winds blew through glassless windows of the small, unfinished building. Texians—as they called themselves—gave birth to a dream. At the town of Washington, fifty-nine representatives voted into existence a sovereign nation: the **REPUBLIC OF TEXAS.**
