When you visit Space Center Houston, you may choose to take a tram tour of the Johnson Space Center (JSC). The Center occupies more than 1,600 acres and employs more than 14,000 people, including contractors and civil servants. Here's what goes on behind the scenes:



JSC is the federal facility, home to the Mission Control Center, where Space Shuttle missions are run from seconds after launch to landing. This is where astronauts are trained and the Space Shuttle program is managed.

JSC also directs the International Space Station (ISS) program. The astronauts who will build and fly on the ISS are training here.

The Center also studies and cares for more than 800 pounds of lunar rocks and soil collected during the Apollo program.

Scientists and engineers work here to study human adaptation to space and develop the technologies that will allow humans to reach out into the Solar System.
